Participles

- **Participle 1** употребляется, когда связанное с ним существительное или местоимение обозначает субъект действия (то есть само выполняет его)
- **Participle 2** неразрывно связано с существительным, как и первое, но это существительное не само является объектом действия, а испытывает его на себе

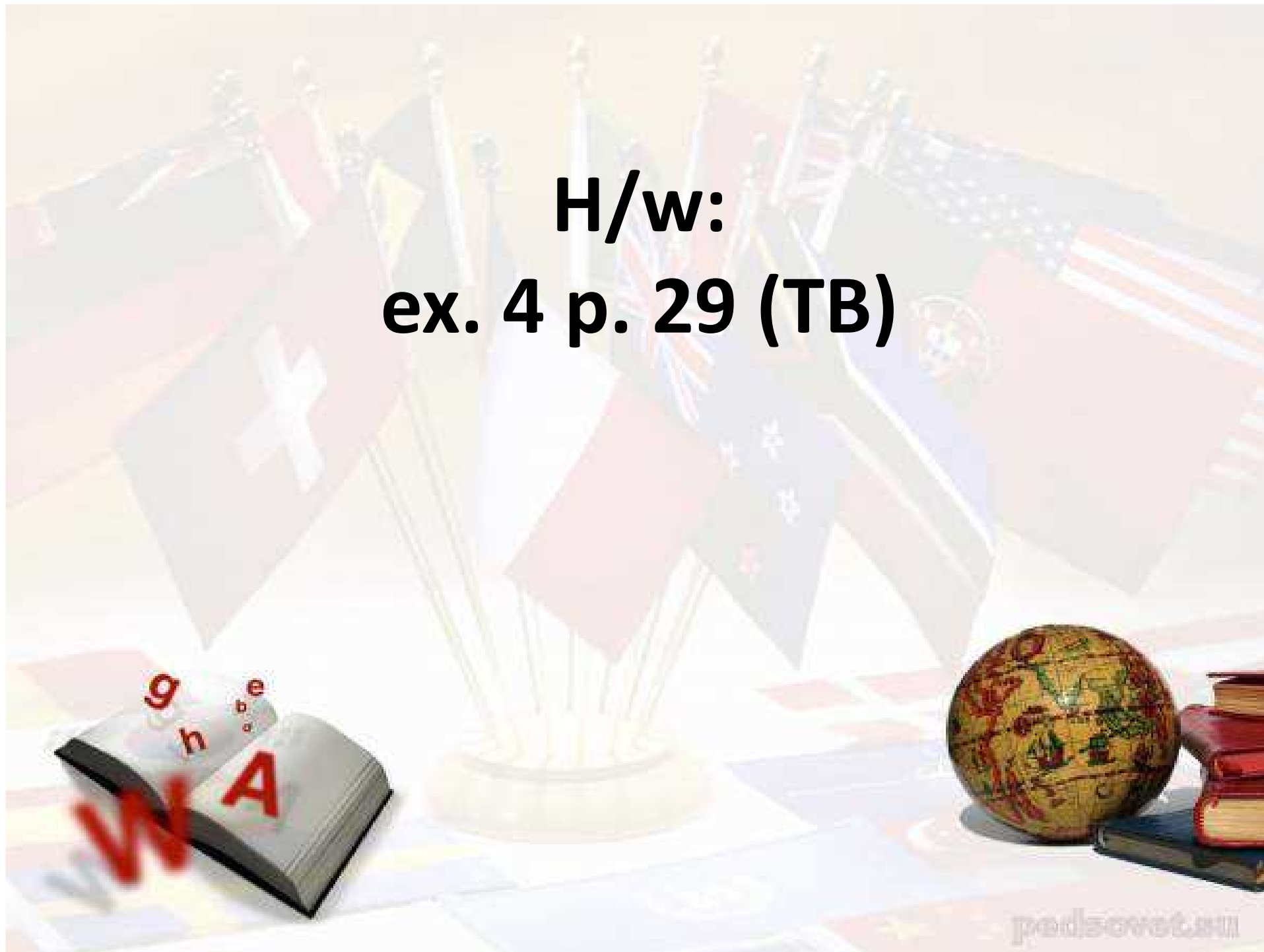
